The October Program

"The Business of Civil War in the North"
By
Dr. Mark R. Wilson

The Union armies that won the Civil War in the field depended on a massive economic mobilization on the home front. In four years of fighting, Union soldiers consumed a billion rounds of small arms ammunition, 100 million pounds of coffee, 10 million pairs of trousers, and a million horses and mules. Historians of the conflict often refer to the North's tremendous advantages in economic resources. Few, however, have done much to describe the economics and politics of the North's giant military procurement project. This presentation will introduce us to the latest research on this important but neglected dimension of Civil War history. Dr. Wilson will explore three major struggles over the North's war economy – political control, how goods were obtained, and corruption and profiteering.

Dr. Mark Wilson is Associate Professor of History at the University of North Carolina – Charlotte. He is author of the book, "The Business of Civil War" (2006). Dr. Wilson holds an A.B. in History and Literature from Harvard, and a Ph.D. in History, with distinction, from the University of Chicago.
